


Evidence for Extraterrestrial Contact





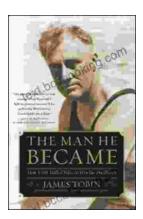
