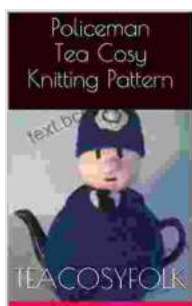

Materials You'll Need:

- 1 skein of worsted weight yarn in navy blue
- 1 skein of worsted weight yarn in white
- A pair of size 8 knitting needles
- A tapestry needle
- A pair of scissors

Abbreviations:

- K: knit
- P: purl
- CO: cast on
- BO: bind off
- St: stitch
- Sts: stitches

Instructions:

1. CO 60 sts in navy blue yarn.
2. K all sts for 1 row.
3. Change to white yarn and k all sts for 3 rows.
4. Change to navy blue yarn and k all sts for 1 row.
5. Repeat steps 3-4 for a total of 10 stripes.
6. Change to white yarn and k all sts for 1 row.
7. Change to navy blue yarn and k all sts for 3 rows.

8. BO all sts.

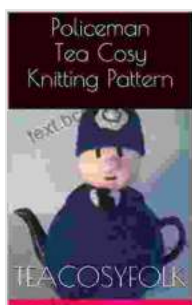
Finishing:

Sew the side seams of the tea cosy together.

Embroider a badge or other embellishments onto the front of the tea cosy, if desired.

We hope you enjoy knitting this tea cosy for the policeman in your life. It's a great way to show your appreciation for their service and dedication.

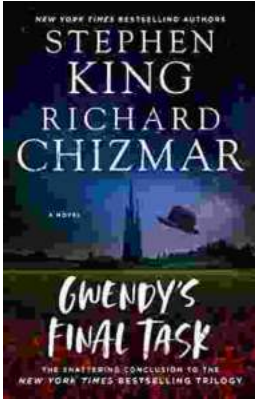

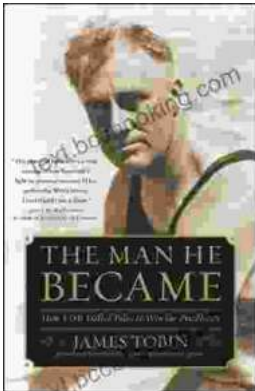
