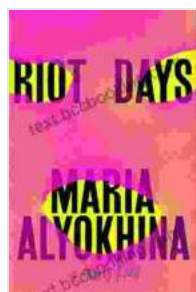


Riot Days: Behind the Scenes of the Pussy Riot Revolution

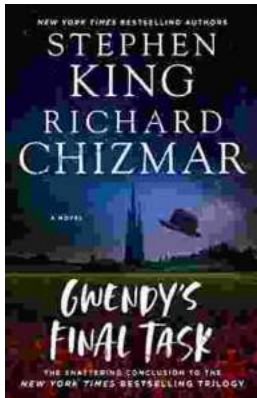

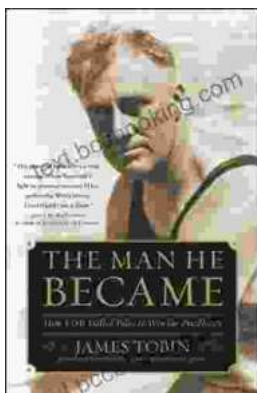
